



Retinal Imaging

The Retinal Imaging takes a view of the back of the eye and puts the image into the format of a picture. This scan can be viewed immediately and examined. The picture allows the Doctor a much wider field of view than most traditional retinal exams provide of your retina. The Doctor recommends that the patients of our office have this procedure done to allow him to utilize all tools available to assess the health of the eyes and especially if any of the following apply:

- * Diabetes
- * Cataracts
- * High Blood Pressure
- * Frequent or Severe Headaches
- * High Nearsightedness
- * Symptoms of Flashes or Floaters
- * Personal or Family History of Glaucoma
- * Over the age of 40

The entire procedure takes less than 5 minutes to complete. There are no side effects to this procedure like those normally associated with dilation, such as sensitivity to light and/or blurry vision.

THE CHARGE OF THIS PROCEDURE IS \$39.00. Vision insurance will not cover this charge. However, Flexible Spending/Health Savings Funds can be used to cover the cost. If you have further questions or concerns, the Doctor will be happy to address those with you during the exam.
